In VCE:

- 17% of all students received an ATAR rank above 90
- 31% of all students achieved an ATAR rank of 80 and above
- 65% of students applied for a tertiary place
- 98% of these students received a first round university offer
- 4% of these students received a TAFE offer
- 5% of students received an offer from an independent training college


Individuality
